Brief description of university, faculty, department, number of students	Karshi Engineering-Economics Institute was established by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan in 1995. Currently, the institute has 6 faculties (Economics, Engineering technology, Geology and Mining, Oil and gas, Energy, Engineering-technical), 31 education departments, the department of science and scientific-pedagogical staff, the center of “Professional Development”, the center of “Gifted Students” and 2 academic lyceums, 2 technical colleges. Today, 9164 bachelors are trained in 37 specialties, 154 masters in 20 specialties, 39 PhD students in the institute. There are 571 teachers, from which 18 are doctors and professors, 120 are PhD professors. International relations are well organized and “The department of international cooperation” is in act. Currently, scientists of the institute are working with more than 20 foreign countries’ (such as Germany, China, Italy, Southern Korea, Netherlands, Poland, USA, Israel, Sweden, Denmark, Greece, Hungary, Portugal, Romania, Austria, Czech Republic, Lithuania, Latvia, Bulgaria, Netherlands, Italy, Spain, Russia, Ukraine, Belarus and Kazakhstan) higher educational institutions based on mutual scientific-applied co-operative contracts. Our several students studied at the foreign higher educational institutions of the countries such as Italy, England, Belgium, Germany, Hungary, Bulgaria, Greece and Romania. More than 70 of our teaching staff members have improved their qualifications in foreign universities.
